Blackjack Tournament

Rules and Procedures

1. Table and seat assignments are by random drawing prior to the start of the flight.
2. Each tournament player receives \$500 in non-negotiable tournament chips at the start of each flight.
3. Minimum bet \$5. Maximum bet \$200.
4. 30 hands per round, one player per spot.
5. The player with the most tournament chips from each table advances to the next round. Four additional hands are used as a tie breaker, when required.
6. A rotating button is used to signify the order of dealing or betting. Button moves one position after each hand.
7. After a bet is placed, it cannot be changed. Players must remove chips from spot after each hand.
8. Any player missing the first two hands of the round will be disqualified.
9. All players must keep their chips separated by denomination and in full view.
10. One player per hand...**NO COACHING ALLOWED.**
11. St. Croix Casino house blackjack rules prevail, except blackjack pays 2 to 1.
12. All players must be 21 years of age or older. The St. Croix Casino reserves the right to refuse tournament entry for any reason, at which time entry fees will be promptly refunded.
13. A player may re-enter a later flight, if space allows.
14. Any time a player is incorrectly paid and it's reported by a player or noticed by the dealer, it shall be corrected immediately, but only prior to the next hand being dealt.
15. The four players not among the top finishers from each table, with the highest tournament chip total, also advance to the playoff round.
16. Any and all disputes will be settled by tournament officials.
